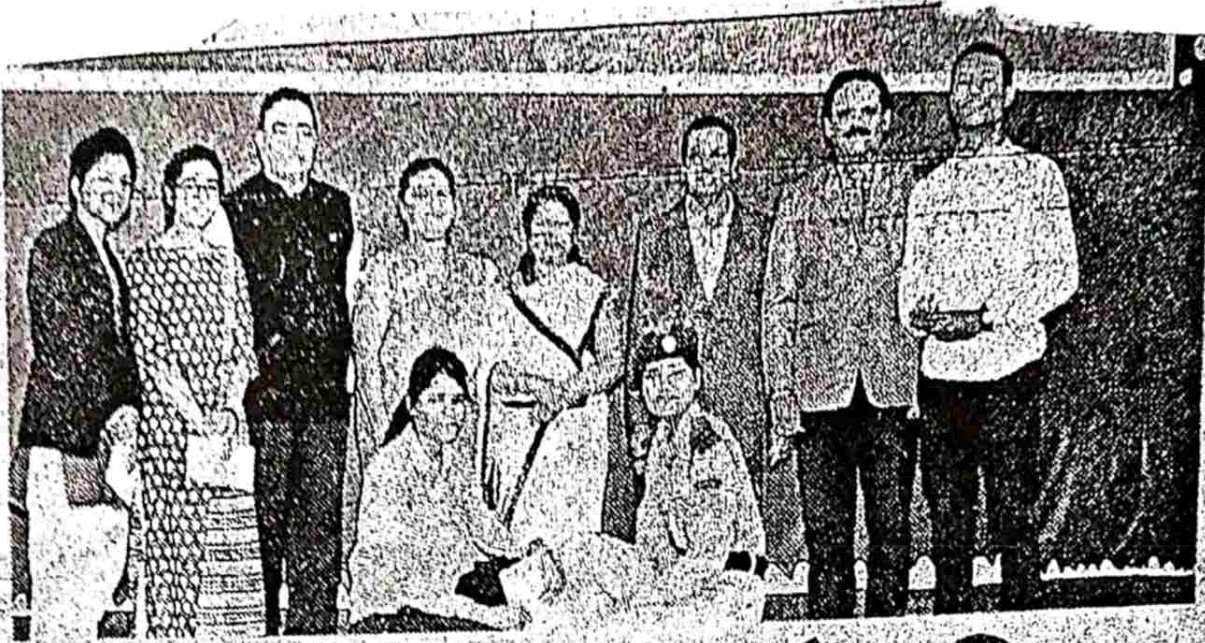

An analysis of Alumni Meet Feedback 2018-19

The Alumni Committee of St. Vincent Pallotti College has obtained Feedback from students of Commerce and Management Department, Computer Department and Education Department through questionnaire which consists of ten questions with three options each viz., "Agree", "Sometimes" and "Disagree" on different parameters those essentially take students' concerns into account on various practices and frameworks. The total students participated from all the department were 150. The report of the same is as follows:


1. **Association with the college-** Students overwhelmingly agreed on the association with the college by giving 100% rating. It can be reasoned with the institute's paramount endurance in setting standards as the first English medium college in the state and by achieving 'Best College' award by Pt. Ravishankar Shukla University in consecutive years i.e., for 2017 and 2018.
2. **Activities for overall development-** 95% of the students asserted that the various activities by the college paved the way for their overall development. 5% ticked sometimes.
3. **Contribution to the Institute** – 100% of the respondents have agreed to their willingness to contribute to the institute. There is no disagreement in this parameter.
4. **Students' grievances redressal** – 85% of alumni agreed with the statement that the grievances of the students were handled properly. A further 10% were positive as they ticked the 'sometimes' category. The remaining 5% were not agreed with the statement.
5. **Adequate laboratories and equipment** – Again 85% of the students agreed with the facilities of necessary laboratories and equipment. A further 10% were also positive by giving it a 'sometimes' rating. Another 5% did not agree to the statement.
6. **Infrastructure-** overall 95% of the students indicated that the institute is having a good infrastructure while 5% i.e one student has not agreed with the statement and another remained neutral.
7. **Resources of Library-** 89% of the alumni feel that the institute's library has rich and useful resources. A further 6% were also positive by giving it a 'sometimes' rating and only 5%, i.e., one student has not agreed with this parameter.

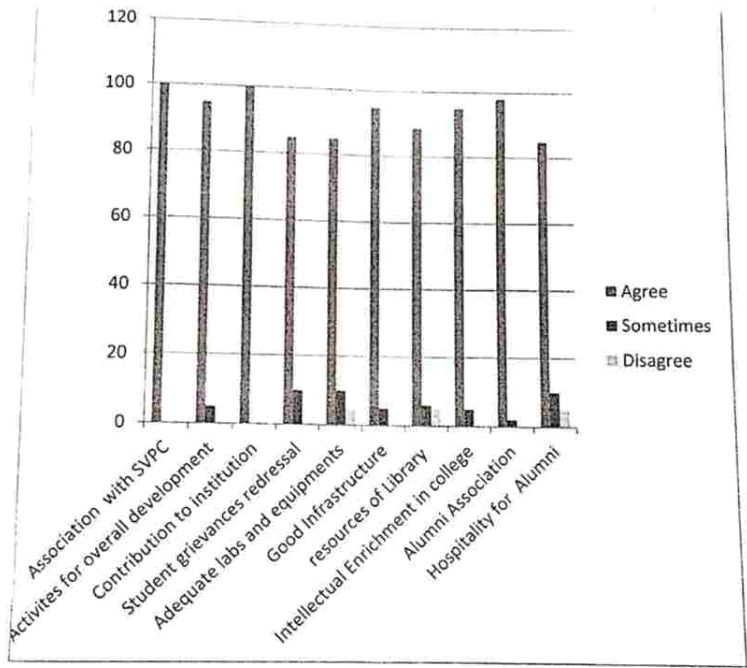
8. **Intellectually enriching** – 95% of the students agreed with the fact that the time they spent in the institute was intellectually enriching and a mere 5%, i.e., two in number feel 'sometimes' for the same.
9. **Alumni Association** – 98% of the students are willing to join the college's alumni association while 2% were remained neutral on this parameter.
10. **Hospitality as an alumni-** on agreeing with the statement that the institute has been providing good hospitality, 85% of the alumni were accepted the same. A further 10% were positive while another 5% were not fully agreed with the parameter.

The overall feedback of the alumni of commerce and management department, Education department and Computer department is significantly positive regarding most of the propositions viz., on association with the college, infrastructure, contribution, resources, intellectual enrichment and hospitality. It is to be noted that a small number of students were seemed to be not satisfied on two criterions viz., Students redressal and more equipment where the institute needs to work out to address the same and take necessary action plan to fix the same and maintain a well supportive atmosphere to foster better engagement as well as relations with the students of alumni. Hence it is proposed to invite the students to expand on any of their ratings by providing comments alongside their choice.

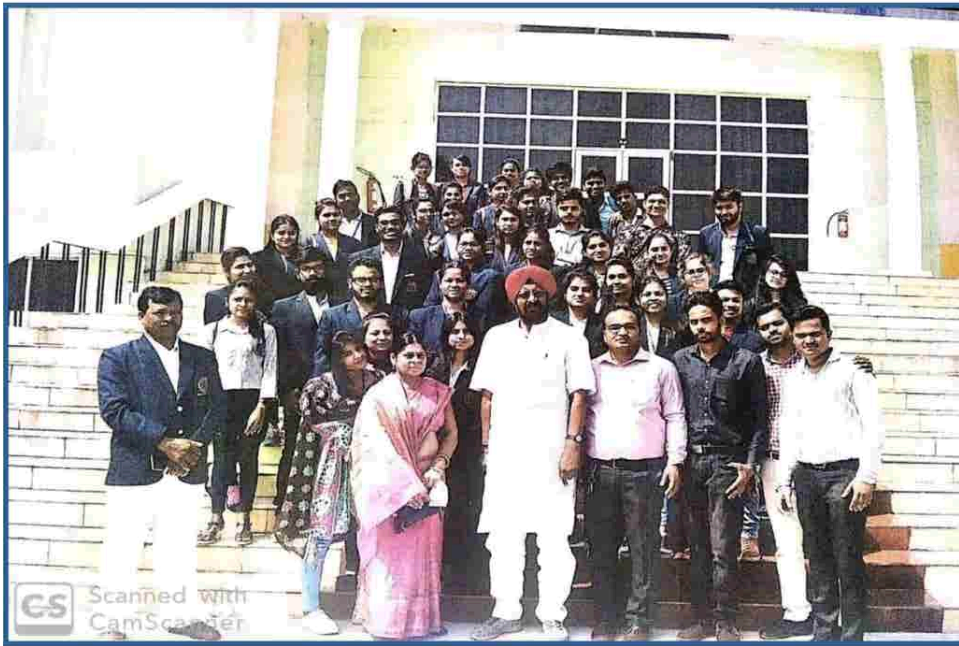


Figure 17 Vidhan Sabha Visit

A Batch of 50 BBA students and three staff coordinators visited the 'Aarti Sponge and power Ltd', established by Mr.Rajiv Mundra , one of the Alumni of St.Vincent Pallotti College. The visit took place on 28.03.2018. This unit is mainly focusing on the preparation of fragrant materials.

Mr. Aditya Mundra owner of the industry addressed the students and introduced about the working of the plant. He explained about the functioning of the each and every branch of the Unit. Later Mr. Sumant Safety officer, explained the different steps employed for the safety of the unit. Most of the raw materials used in the preparation of iron ore and coal are highly flammable. He also warned the students how to reach a safe assembly point if any accident happens in the unit during visit.

Later Mr. Gupta, HR Manager explained the agenda of the day. The agenda was training on:

1. Basic Plant Introduction
2. Iron melting unit
3. Processing unit
4. Electricity chamber
5. Plant tour


